- ♥ Informal Caregiving— providing care to an individual who needs assistance with activities of daily living.
- ♥ Formal Caregiving— providing paid care in an individual's home or a group setting.
- Kinship Caregiving—the care of children and adolescents by family friends and relatives.
- ♥ Foster Care— a system of care in which a minor is placed with a state-approved "foster parent" in a private or group setting.
